Your Data, Your Information


What is your data?

Data is any information collected about you.



Research data is collected to answer a specific research question.

For example, which pill lowers blood pressure better? Red or Blue?



Joining a study is your choice.

Your data will be collected with your consent.



Research teams apply a code to your data to protect your privacy and make it harder to link the data back to you.

You have the right to ask questions about your data.

- · What data will you collect from me?
- How will you use my data?
- · How will you protect my data?
- What are the risks of giving you my data?
- Will anyone else see or use my data?
- What will happen to my data when the study is over?
- Will you share the results of the study?
- Will I learn the results of the study?
- If someone sees my data who should not, what happens?
